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COVID-19 RESPONSE FOR ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOANS

Once the SBA disaster declaration is approved, applications will be made available for the state/territory at www.sba.gov/disaster. This may take a few days from the approval notifications for the data input to be completed. Small business owners would then apply online for financial assistance in the Disaster Portal at https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela/.

The electronic loan application will be screened by our processing center when it is received.

BASED ON CURRENT INFORMATION, THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR ALL EIDL APPLICATIONS:

- Loan application (SBA Form 5), completed and signed (this is electronic in the portal)
- Tax Information Authorization (IRS Form 4506-T), completed and signed by each applicant, which includes 1) each principal owning 20 percent or more of the applicant business, 2) each general partner or managing member; and, 3) for any owner who has more than 50 percent ownership in an affiliate business. Affiliates include, but are not limited to, business parents, subsidiaries, and/or other businesses with common ownership or management
- Complete copies, including all schedules, of the most recently filed Federal income tax returns for the applicant business; an explanation if not available
- Personal Financial Statement (SBA Form 413) completed, signed, and dated by the applicant, again for each principal owning 20 percent or more of the applicant business, and each general partner or managing member
- Schedule of Liabilities listing all fixed debts (SBA Form 2202 may be used)
